I recently received an email from the FAA stating its time renew my Small UAS Certificate of Registration. They couldn't have made it easier. Just go to the provided website and follow the instructions. You need to login with your user's name and password. Be sure to register as a recreational hobbyist. You are required to take the recreational UAS safety test (TRUST). I selected the AMA written test. Never fear, you can correct any wrong answers. Also, there is a section to register your airplanes. You need to identify at least one plane. The cost is \$5 to renew for another 3-years. After completion, you get a new Registration Certificate and a test certificate. Remember, the flying field is a designated FAA site that does not require FAA submitted flight plans.
