A number of years ago, Gib started building a P-47N. The wing, fuselage and tail surfaces are framed up. This last week, I moved the wing to my house and started repairing dings and getting it ready to be sheeted. We want to add bomb drop and rocket firing before it is closed up. We have a 3 cylinder, 4.2 cu in Saito engine for it.

In 1948, P-47s were flown out of Great Falls using 300 gallon paper water tanks which were dropped on forest fires. Apparently, it worked fairly well. The tanks burst when they hit the ground and spread the water around in a wide area.
